# 5. Action Items

# Dr. Walker Review Results (Senator Carhart)

• Motion to have the list of suggestions provided by the Senate Executive Committee be sent to the President of the University to seek his response to these suggestions for future planning and processing. The Senate should request a specific response by the president to each suggestion and a plan for concrete action regarding each suggestion.

Approved 92% in favor, 3% not in favor, 6

errors and violations of due process and other violations that have occurred as noted in the Executive Committee Report. Once an agreed upon list of strategies has been devised, the Senate should jointly with these other organizations send these to the president of the university and request a detailed response to the list of proposed strategies.

• Rationale for this motion is:

EC recommendations only recount the facts of the case rather than addressing the issues identified. The purpose of this motion is to ask the administration how they intend to address the issues identified in the future.

Approved 76% in favor, 18% not in favor, 6% abstain
